

MOU JCIC-UniKL 2016

On July 20th, 2016 JCIC signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with University Kuala Lumpur.

JCIC and UniKL will jointly achieve the following objectives:

- To develop cooperation in industrial knowledge and know-how and to promote mutual understandings between both parties.
- To explore various potentials between the Parties within any field related to management, and business training industry that will benefit the Parties.
- To share available resources and expertise for the purpose of education, professional programmes, short courses, research and development and other related services that will benefit the Parties.

Both Parties shall endeavor to undertake the following activities:

- 1.To exchange and share technical know-how and expertise;
- 2.To jointly run educational, training and/or research activities
- 3.To exchange of invitations to scholars (faculty, research personnel, and graduate students) for lectures, visits and sharing of experiences.
- 4.To exchange of invitations to scholars for participation in conferences, symposia and seminars.
- 5.To co-sponsor seminars, courses, workshops and other academic meetings on matters of mutual benefit.
- 6.To assist with developing relations and cooperation with industry and other institutes in each country.
- 7.To developing joint dual training programs. The details to be considered by both parties, with possible separate development and agreement, according to operational requirements.
